1. Introduction

The SST-RMS05-22 rail kit is designed to support rack-mount installation of the Kneron KNEO350 AI Server into standard 19-inch server rack cabinets. Manufactured with precision mounting holes and high-strength steel, this product provides a secure and convenient connection between the KNEO350 chassis and the server rack. In addition to its tool-less design, screw mounting provisions are also available for additional security.

2. Special Features

- Tool-less design for easy installation and removal
- Maximum loading capacity up to 77.16 lbs (35 kg)
- Supports 3U and 4U chassis form factors
- Supports 440 mm wide chassis (compatible with KNEO350)

4. Installation Procedure

Follow the steps below to install the KNEO350 AI Server into a server rack cabinet using the RMS05-22 rail kit. Please read all steps carefully before beginning installation.

Step 1 — Release and detach the inner member from the slide.

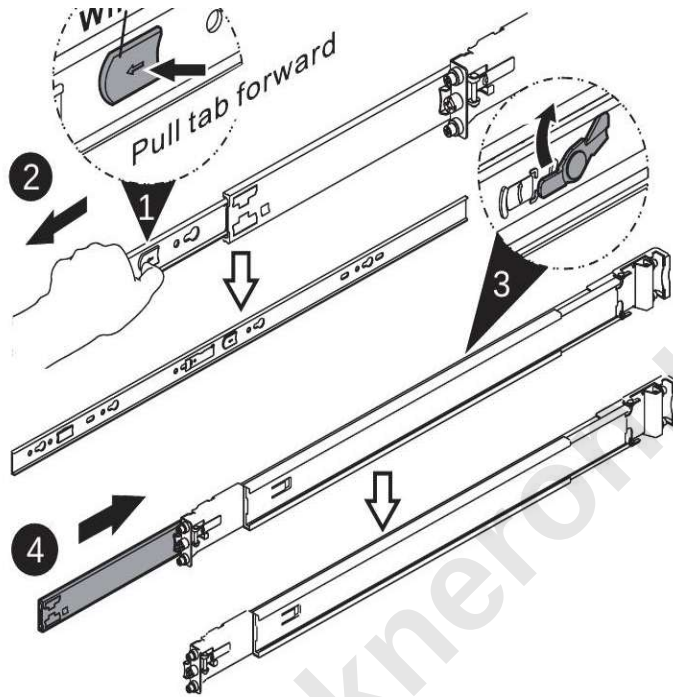


Figure 2 Step 1 — Detaching the inner rail member from the outer/middle assembly

Step 2 — Attach the inner member to the KNEO350 chassis.

Align the inner rail member with the mounting holes on the side of the KNEO350 chassis. Press until the stud clicks into the keyhole slot to secure. Repeat for the opposite side.

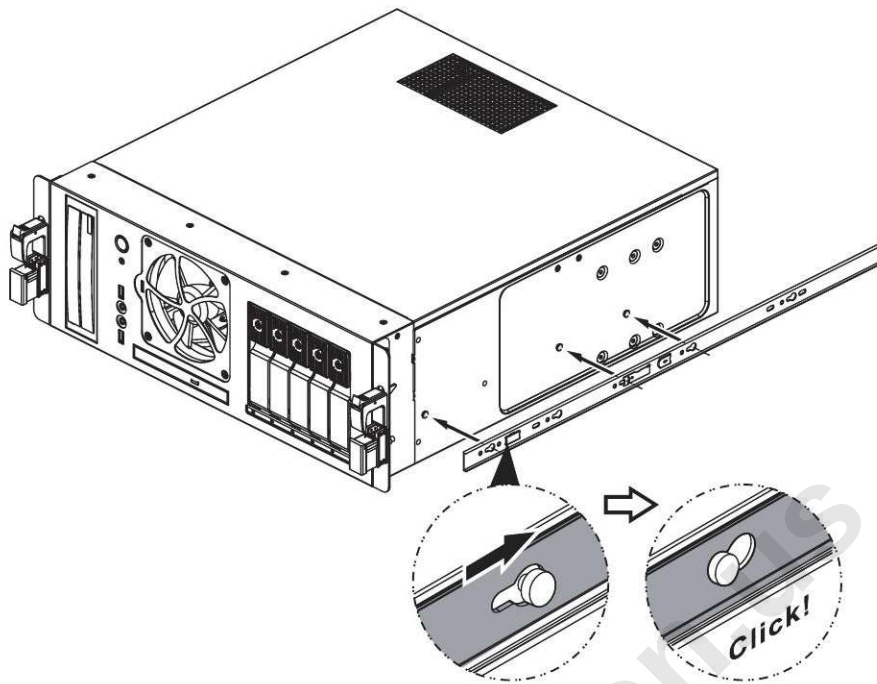


Figure 3 Step 2 — Attaching the inner rail member to the KNEO350 chassis

Step 3 — Attach the outer member to the rack cabinet.

Hook the front bracket of the outer rail member onto the front rack post. Extend the rail to reach the rear post and hook it in. Press until both front and rear clips click securely into the rack post holes. Repeat for the other side.

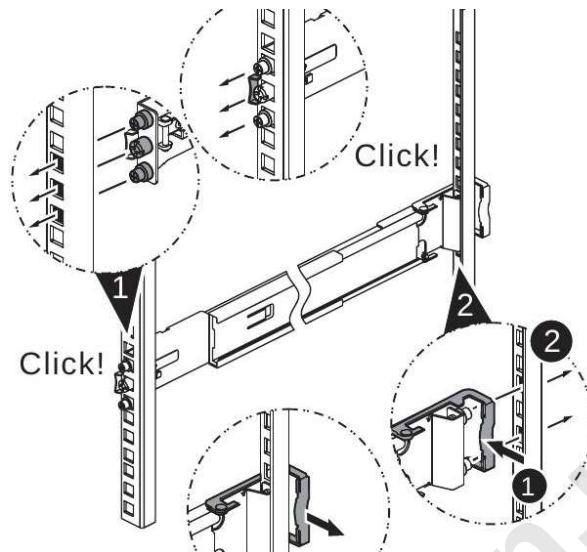


Figure 4 Step 3 — Mounting the outer rail member to the server rack cabinet

Step 4 — Insert the KNEO350 chassis to complete the installation.

Step 4.1. Pull the middle rail member out to the fully extended locked position.

Step 4.2. Ensure the ball bearing retainer is located at the front of the middle member.

Step 4.3. Align the inner members (attached to the chassis) with the middle-outer rail assembly and slide the chassis in.

Step 4.4. When the chassis hits a stop, pull or push the blue release tab to unlock and continue retracting the chassis fully into the rack.

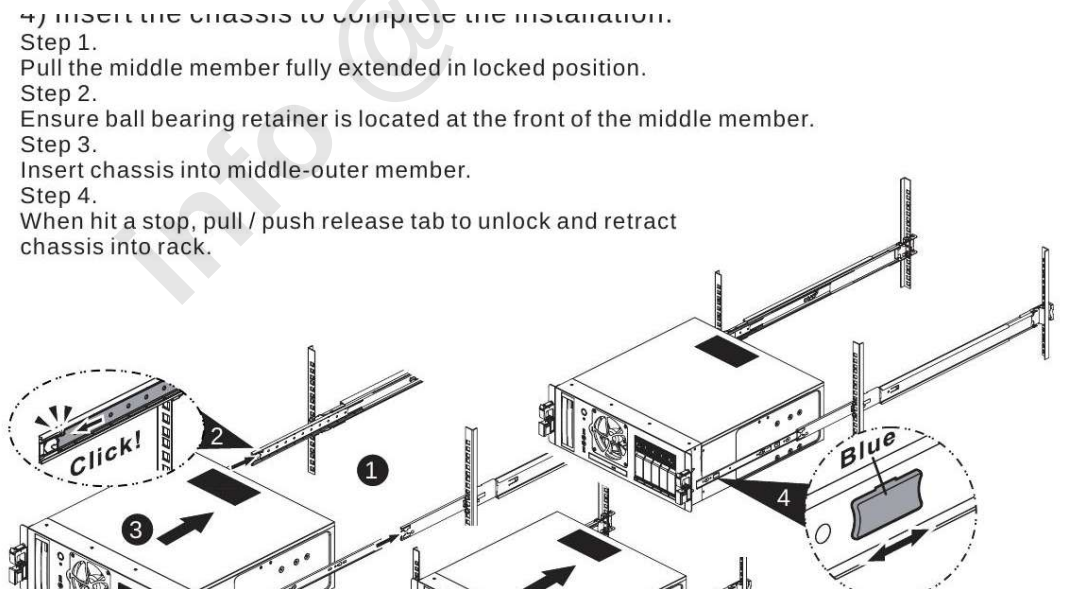


Figure 5 Step 4 — Inserting the KNEO350 chassis into the rack

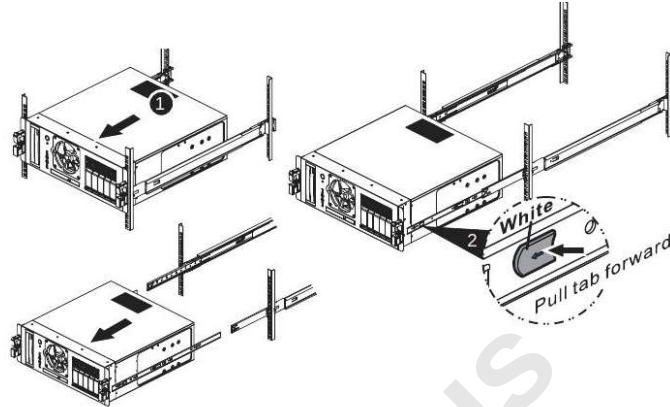
5. Removing the Chassis from the Rack

Step 5.1. Pull the KNEO350 chassis out until the rails are fully extended and locked in position.

Step 5.2. Pull the white disconnect tab forward (toward the front of the chassis) to release the inner member and fully remove the chassis from the rack.

Step 1.
Pull the rails fully extended
in locked position.

Step 2.
Pull the disconnect tab forward
to remove chassis.
